FOUR WEEK CAMPERS: For boys age 8-15 Fees: \$4400.00 (CAD)

JULY: Sunday June 28-Saturday July 25

AUGUST: Thursday July 30-Wednesday August 26

TWO WEEK CAMPERS..... Fees: \$2500.00 (CAD)

JULY: Sunday June 28-Saturday July 11 or Sunday July 12-Saturday July 25

Boys age 7-9 years as of July 1st, 2020

AUGUST: Thursday July 30-Wednesday August 12 or Thursday August 13-Wednesday August 26

Boys age 7-10 years as of July 1st, 2020. Boys age 10 are eligible for a two week session only if enrolling for the first time.

ONE WEEK CAMPERS Fees: \$1350.00 (CAD)

For first year boys entering Grade 2 in September 2020, we are offering this new option.

COUNSELLOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM..... Fees: \$2500.00 (CAD)

The camp charters buses to take campers from Toronto to Ponacka on June 28 and July 30 and to bring campers back to Toronto on July 25 and August 26. A Ponacka counsellor escorts each bus. We are happy to pick up and return campers to Toronto Pearson International Airport. The above fees do not include: Transportation to/from camp, laundry, tuck shop purchases, riding, 13% HST, award fees from canoeing, sailing and swimming associations.

2020 Payment and Refund Policy

WE WILL HOLD A PLACE FOR EACH 2019 CAMPER UNTIL DECEMBER 1ST, 2019. PLEASE ADVISE US OF YOUR PLANS FOR YOUR SON, BY THAT DATE!

At the time of registration, with each camper application, a deposit of \$1000.00 is due, of which \$100.00 is non-refundable. Please make cheques payable to **Camp Ponacka** (in Canadian Funds) or send an electronic transfer to info@ponacka.com. We do not accept credit cards.

For international families: To avoid additional bank charges, please send wire transfers in Canadian funds only.

On May 1st, 2020 for July campers and June 1st for August campers, the balance of fees, taxes, tuck deposit and other incidental expenses are due. A detailed remittance form will be sent to you prior to those dates. Late payments are subject to a penalty of \$50.

A boy cannot be considered enrolled (or on the waiting list) unless his application and \$1000.00 deposit is on file.

If advice of withdrawal is received before March 15th, all fees will be returned except the \$100.00 registration fee. If advice of withdrawal is received before April 1st, half the deposit will be retained but \$400.00 may be applied to a 2021 registration. The other \$500.00 will be

refunded. After May 1st, or June 1st respectively, the camp may retain the entire camper fee.

If a boy is unable to start camp on time or not at all because of illness, or if he leaves early because of illness, the camper fee is shared equally by parents and Camp.

There is no reduction in fees for boys arriving late or leaving early. If we cannot find a place for a boy on the waiting list or if his registration is withdrawn for any reason before a place becomes available, all monies will be refunded. If he is offered a place but does not take advantage of it, \$100.00 of his deposit will be retained. Please be assured that cancellations due to circumstances beyond your control will meet with our utmost co-operation. We will certainly attempt to find a replacement camper and minimize your financial loss. However, we reserve the right to apply the above conditions.
